

Building Blocks I Summer 2023

Building Blocks I is a small group program designed for 2- to 3-year-old children with difficulties in language, sensory/emotional regulation, and/or social communication development. Grounded in the SCERTS model and using principles of naturalistic developmental behavioral intervention, our daily schedule includes typical preschool activities such as circle time, center time, snack, art/sensory play, and gross motor play on our indoor playground. Skills developed include developmentally appropriate speech and language targets, functional social communication within the natural context, participation in group activities, and joint play skills. Each class will be led by 1-2 speech-language pathologists and supported by graduate students in speech-language pathology from the UTD-Callier Center. Class size will be limited to no more than 6 children.

Classes are held at the SCC Clinic, located at 4600 Greenville Ave., Suite 160, Dallas, TX 75206. All summer camp sessions are 4 mornings per week, Monday through Thursday from 9:00 am – 12 pm.

*<u>Please note:</u> If you are a new client to SCC, we require a recent speech-language evaluation (within past 6 months) and a 30-minute intake consultation (\$85) to occur prior to camp to assure placement in the correct group and to set appropriate targets for your individual child for his/her time in camp.

In order to provide maximum flexibility for our SCC families, we will offer Building Blocks enrollment for 2 summer terms. Enrollment in either or both terms is welcome, pending availability.

Building Blocks is a tuition-based, private pay program. Tuition is <u>non-refundable</u> for class days missed. We will not be able to offer credits or refunds for any sessions cancelled for any reason, including group/Clinic closure or student absence.
