

Girls' Afternoon Out Summer 2023

Girls' Afternoon Out is a small group social communication and social skills program designed especially for 4- to 5-year-old girls. The focus of the girls' time together is on development of the distinctive conversational and play skills necessary to building little girl friendships. Using foundational principles of the SCERTS model and Social Thinking TM , we have built our own unique curriculum designed around developmentally appropriate "girlie" themes, such as tea parties, princesses, art, and dress up!

Our daily schedule will include structured teaching, facilitated play in semi-structured group time, and unstructured facilitated interactions with peers. Skills developed will include sharing, turn-taking, social conversation with peers, conflict resolution, participation in group activities, emotional regulation tools, and coordinated joint pretend play. Class size will be limited to 6 children.

"Right Fit" young ladies are highly verbal and continue to demonstrate challenges with social conversations and interactions with peers. Emotional regulation may also be a challenge.

*Please note: If you are a new client to SCC, we require a recent speech-language evaluation (within past 6 months) and a 30-minute intake consultation (\$85) prior to the start of the term to ensure correct placement and to set appropriate targets for your child.

Classes will be held on Monday and Wednesday afternoons from 2:00-3:30 pm. In order to provide maximum flexibility for our SCC families, we will offer Girls' Afternoon Out enrollment for 2 summer terms and with a choice of enrolling in classes once (Mondays) or twice (Mondays and Wednesdays) a week. Enrollment in either or both terms is welcome, pending availability.
